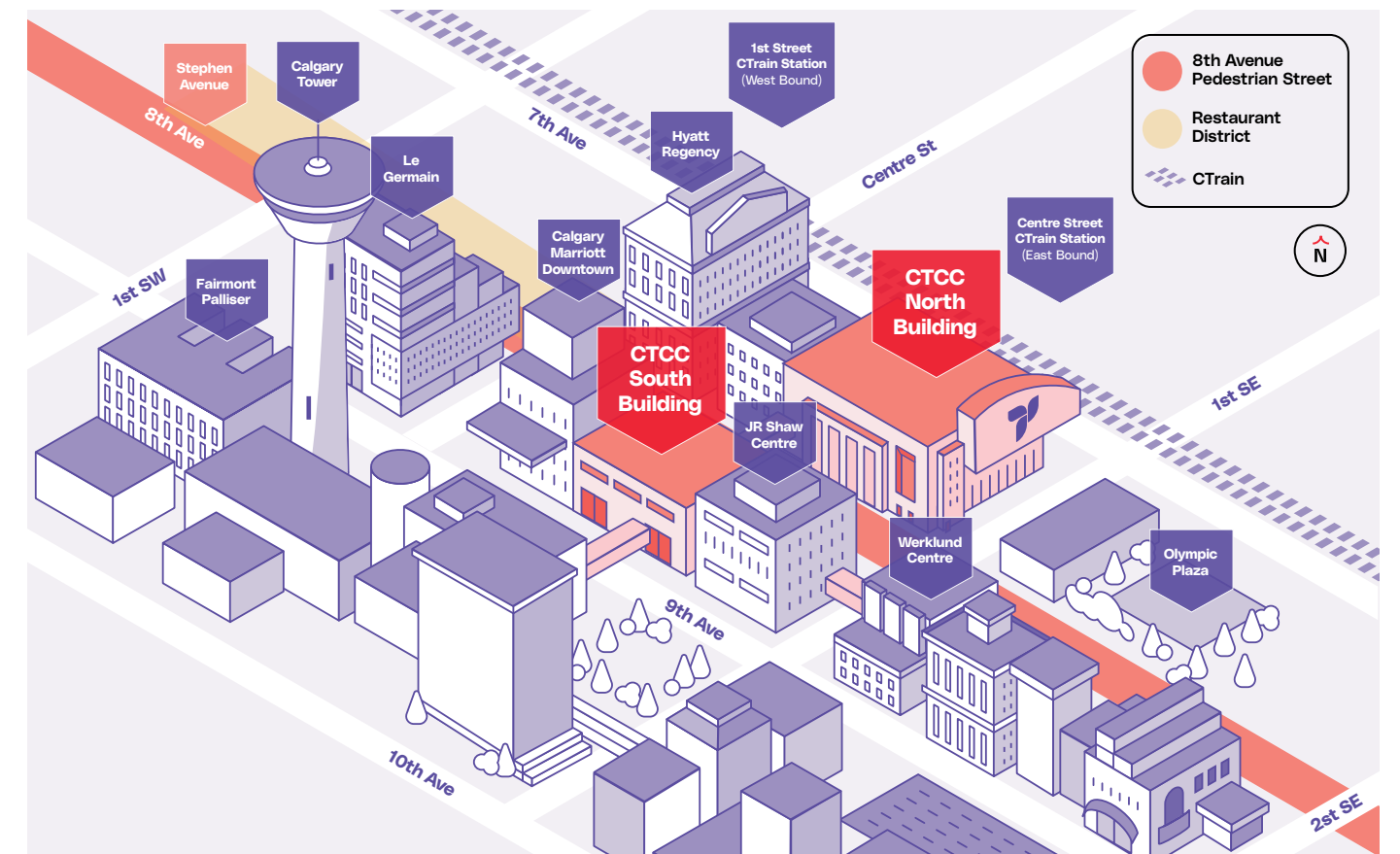
## Your event, your way.

## Offsite Experiences

**OLYMPIC PLAZA**  
First created for the 1988 Winter Olympics medal ceremonies, this urban park is one of Calgary's most well-known gathering spaces. You'll often come across festivals and events at the plaza, and in the winter, it transforms into a public skating rink.

**JR SHAW CENTRE FOR ARTS & CULTURE (GLENBOW)**  
This museum is home to the largest public art collection in Western Canada. Guided by the belief that art is for everyone, the centre offers free general admission to its incredible exhibitions, displays, and installations.

**WERKLUND CENTRE**  
Western Canada's largest arts centre is home to six resident companies, including the award winning Calgary Philharmonic Orchestra. The Werklund Centre hosts a range of concerts, theatre productions, dance events, and more.

**CALGARY TOWER**  
This iconic building may no longer hold the title of the tallest in Calgary, but remains the most recognizable. Boasting 360-degree views of the city from the top observation deck and the opportunity to dine in a revolving restaurant more than 150 metres above ground level, the tower offers a unique perspective on the city.

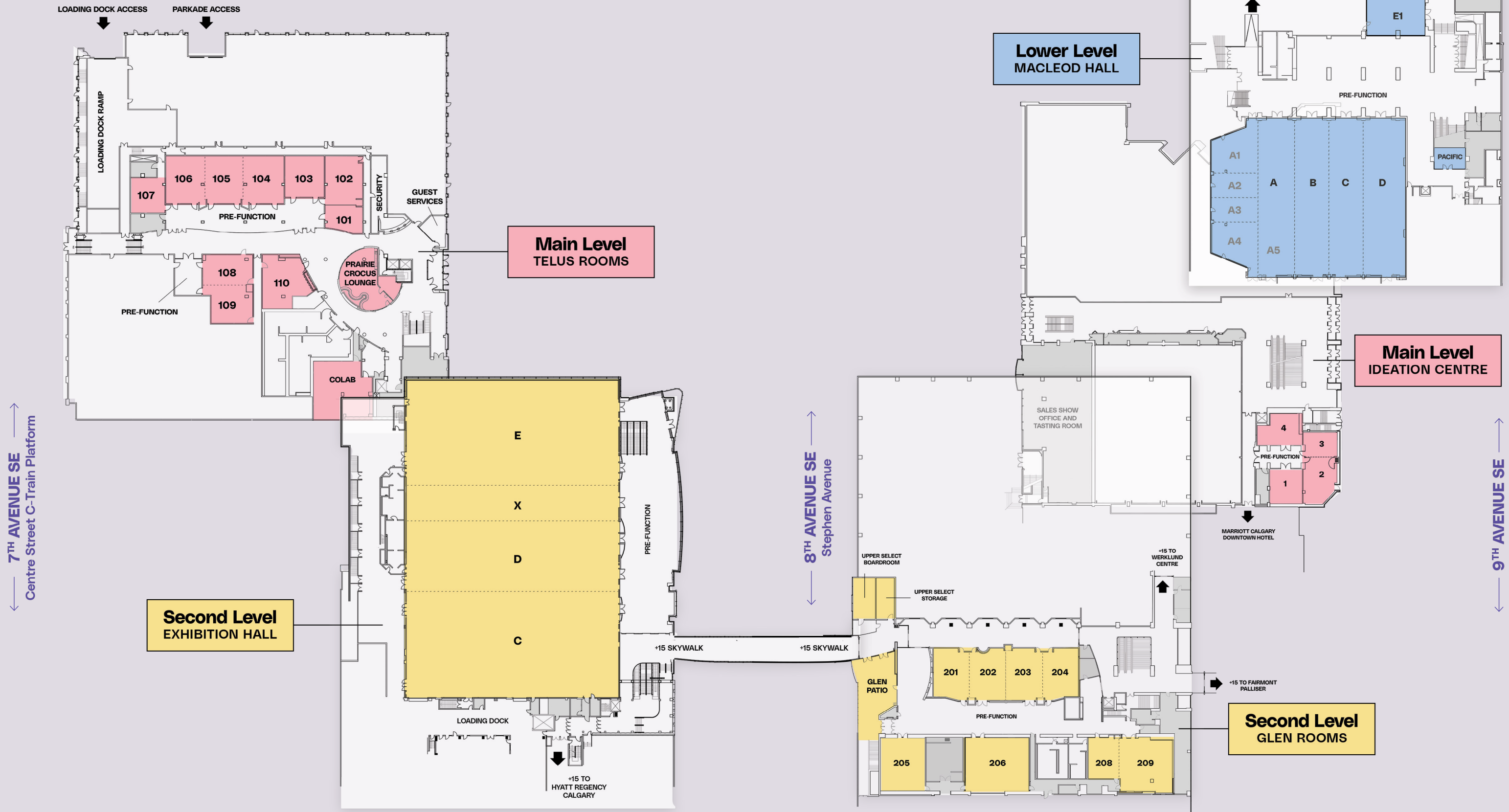
## 07 Technology

- + Includes the Upper Select Boardroom, a fully networked executive corner office, with a great view of Stephen Avenue



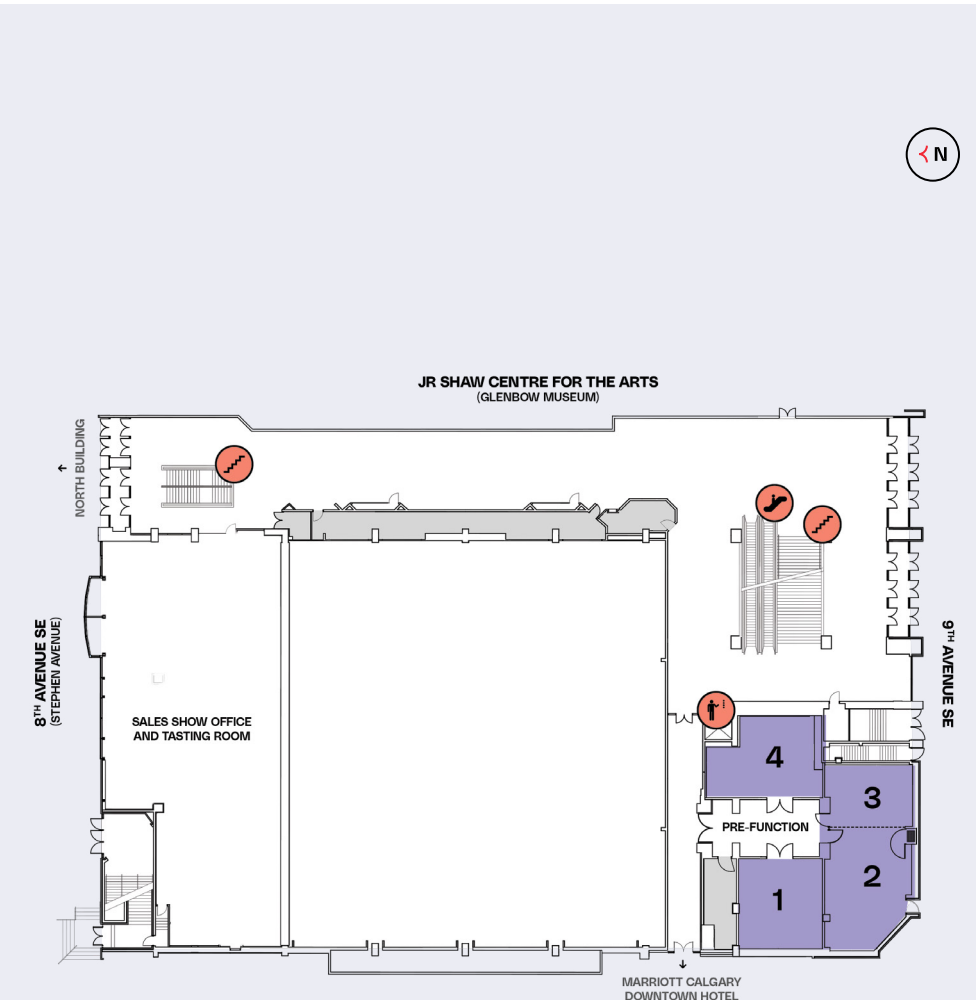

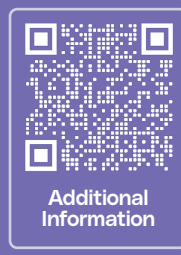
